Thursday - September 6

- 09:00am -Meet at Meijer parking lot (1/2 mile from hotel) for departure to Pleasant Hill, KY. This is a very scenic drive winding through the Kentucky River basin ending up at Shaker Village.
- 10:00am -Take a guided tour of Shaker Village of approximately an hour and a half followed by lunch in the Trustees' Office. We'll also enjoy a short Shaker musical performance in the Meeting House. (Lunch & tour is included in registration)
- 02:00pm -Drive approximately ½ mile down to the Kentucky River and take a ride on a paddle wheeler, the Dixie Belle. This is a very scenic and entertaining ride through the Kentucky River "palisades" and under "High Bridge". (Admission is included in registration)
- 03:00pm -Return to Shaker Village for shopping or self-guided tour (optional) and then return to hotel.
- 07:00pm -Reception at the hotel. We'll have it out on the patio (weather permitting) that overlooks a lake with a large fountain. A soloist will provide the entertainment.

The first will take the distillery tour while the second has lunch and vice versa. (Lunch & tour is included in registration)
- 02:00pm -Driving Tour through the Bluegrass to Donamire Horse Farm for a guided tour. This very impressive 600-acre Thoroughbred breeding farm includes its own training center.
- 4:00pm -Continue on the Bluegrass driving tour and return to hotel
